The Ministry of Finance and Planning has received financing in the amount of Euro 2,670,000.00 equivalent to US \$3,129,032.00 from the European Union (EU), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under the project Climate Change Adaptation Investments for Paramaribo's Resilience (Complimentary financing to PURP I). Bidding will be governed by the Inter-American Development Bank's eligibility rules and procedures.

The main objectives of this project are to contribute to the socio-economic revitalization of Paramaribo's historical center. The specific objectives are: (i) restore to value cultural heritage through the attraction of social and commercial activities; (ii) strengthen the institutional framework for managing its sustainable development; and (iii) increase climate adaptation capacity.

The project consists of four main components. Component finances the design and implementation of strategic urban interventions intended to revert the physical deterioration in the historic center to trigger a sustainable revitalization process. Component 2 includes Financial Instruments which supports the design of a financial scheme to incentivize the participation of the private sector in the renovation of buildings for commercial and residential use. Component 3 finances the strengthening of the Directorate Culture at the Ministry of Education, Science and Culture (MESC), and the development of key planning instruments to guide the historic city center revitalization process in a suitable manner. Component 4 will support the preparation and execution of adaptation measures in Paramaribo WHS, mainly gray and green infrastructure required to increase heritage, public space, and urban mobility resilience to flooding events estimated to increment in magnitude frequency. Activities to strengthen institutional adaptation knowledge and capacities will be supported.



Procurement processes of contracts financed by the European Union will be conducted in accordance with the *Policies for Procurement of Goods and Works financed by the Inter-American Development Bank* (GN-2349-15), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the policies. Eligible bidders include national consultants, contractors and suppliers of member countries of the Inter-American Development Bank and the European Union. Consulting services will be selected and contracted in accordance with the *Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank* (GN-2350-15).

Specific procurement notices for contracts to be bid under the Inter-American Development Bank's international competitive bidding (ICB) procedures, will be published as they become available. For consulting services expected to cost an amount equivalent to US \$200.000 or more, a request for expressions of interest contracts will be advertised in <u>UN Development Businessⁱ</u>, till the end of March 2025, Client Portal after March 2025, the <u>Inter-American Development Bank's</u> Web Site and local daily newspaper "Times of Suriname", "Dagblad Suriname" and "De West". As well as on the PURP Facebook page and Website (<u>https://purp.sr/en/announcements/</u>). Advertisements will be published during the period 2025 – 2026.
